- Prediabetes (Impaired FBG): Between 100-125 mg/dL (5.6-6.9 mmol/L)
- Diabetes: 126 mg/dL (7.0 mmol/L) or higher

Elevated FBG levels signal potential issues with glucose metabolism, a key factor in diabetes. Early detection through FBG testing allows for prompt intervention to manage or prevent diabetes-related complications.

Regular FBG testing is crucial for assessing diabetes risk and maintaining overall health. By understanding and monitoring FBG levels, individuals can take proactive steps towards managing their metabolic health effectively.


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
